A Family Program

- Family involvement is key
- For Lions & Tigers- An adult partner is required at all meetings and events
- For Wolves & Bears- Adult participation in meetings is helpful and makes them go smoother but is not required. <u>An adult</u> <u>partner is required at events.</u>
- Webelos 1 & 2- Adult assistance in meetings and events is still needed but the scouts will slowly begin to do things on their own in preparation of crossing over to Scouts.
- Families are welcome to nearly all Cub Scout events
 - "Webelos Only" events are the only exception to this.





- In Cub Scouts, Akela is a symbol of wisdom, authority, and leadership.
- Akela is anyone who acts as a leader to the Scout. Akela can be a Cubmaster, Den Leader, parent or teacher depending on where the guidance takes place.
- In den meetings, it is the Den Leader who is Akela. During pack meetings it is the Cubmaster. At home, the parents fill this role.
- You are Akela so you can sign off on completed assignments.





- Trained Adult Leaders
 - All leaders and adults are required to complete BSA Youth Protection Training.
- Two Deep Leadership
 - No one-on-one contact with a scout
- Background checks on all adult leaders
- Scouts must complete safety requirements for rank each year:
 - Youth Protection Training at home with parents/guardians
 - Cyber Chip Internet Safety Training (online)
